To prepare the student to assume civic responsibility, to respect property (both public and private, to desire to be of service to his fellow man and to know how to become economically self-sufficient, while contributing the most of which he is capable.

To acquaint the student with the wonders of the human body and to help him understand how he grows and develops.

To offer an opportunity for each child to develop physically, mentally, socially and emotionally. To make the student aware of his great American heritage so that he might better understand the present and bring knowledge to bear upon the future.
