102.2 FAILED SUBJECTS - TUTORING

FAILED SUBJECTS - TUTORING

- 1. An "F" grade is represented as a failure to meet the basic objectives of the course.
- 2. A student may be allowed to complete work in a subject in which he/she received an "F" by approval of the Principal if this will result in a change of retention-promotion or graduation:
 - 1. Repeating the subject as part of the student's regular school schedule; however, only with approval of the Administration may subjects that are sequential be taken out of order.

 (Example: student taking trigonometry before geometry)
 - 2. Summer sessions at any high school offering programs acceptable to the School Administrator.
 - 3. Tutoring, in exceptional cases where no other arrangements can be made, by a certified teacher, and with the approval of the Principal, with the following minimum hours of instruction:
 - a. For two nine-week periods-failure in a subject-24 hours.
 - b. For three nine-week periods- failure in a subject- 36 hours.
