210. MEDICATION AND FIRST AID

1. Purpose

The Board shall not be responsible for the diagnosis and treatment of student illness. The administration of prescribed medication in accordance with the direction of a parent or family physician to a student during school hours will be permitted according to the following.

The Board recognizes the fact that there will be occasions when an employee of the District might be required to administer basic first aid for a minor injury in the absence of a school nurse, or supervise the taking of a prescribed drug by a student(s).

It should be kept in mind that at no time should an injury be treated which requires a skill or knowledge which exceeds that held by the employee. The circumstances surrounding the accident should dictate how an employee reacts and what prudent steps are taken by him/her.

It is further affirmed that the school district and its employees do not assume any responsibility when a prescribed drug is taken by a student under an employee's supervision. A note from either the parent(s) or attending physician, which gives permission to the employee(s) to supervise the taking of a drug by a student, must accompany the student and be presented to the employee or must be in the hand of the building principal before the taking of a prescribed drug will be permitted.

At no time should an employee attempt to personally administer a prescribed drug regardless of the circumstances.
