211.1 INSURANCE

1. Providing insurance for students insofar as injury is concerned shall be a responsibility of the parents. The School System may make a program available to parents but shall not obligate parents to purchase such a program.
2. The School assumes no financial responsibility for injuries and accidents that happen to students in classes such as gym, metal shop, chemistry, etc. or other places on the premises.
 - a. First aid shall be rendered by the school nurse or other qualified staff as the occasion may demand. In severe cases, the school will call parents, or, if unable to contact parents, will transport or have transported the student to an emergency facility.
 - b. Parents are responsible for transportation costs and medical costs even when initial decision to transport is made by school authorities.
3. No pupil may take part in any interscholastic athletics of any nature without a successful physical examination by a medical doctor as required by the P.I.A.A.
