## 212. REPORTING PUPIL PROGRESS

1. Purpose Pol. 216

The Board believes that the cooperation of school and home is a vital ingredient in the growth and education of the whole child. It recognizes its responsibility to keep parents informed of student welfare and progress in school. It also recognizes the effects of State Board regulations and Federal Regulations governing school regards. (Pol. 216)

2. Authority

The Board directs the establishment of a system of reporting student progress which shall include written reports and parent conferences with teachers and shall require all appropriate staff members to comply with such a system as part of their teaching responsibility.

3. Delegation of Responsibility

The Superintendent in conjunction with appropriate teaching staff members shall develop procedures for reporting student progress to parents or guardians which enable the scheduling of parent-teacher conferences at such item and in such places as will ensure the greatest degree of participation by parents, and not preclude the participation of either parent.
