223. USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES

1. Purpose

The Board regards the use of motor vehicles for travel to and from school by students as an assumption of responsibility by parents/guardians and students.

2. Authority

The Board shall permit the use of motor vehicles by secondary students in accordance with district rules, provided that such students have followed established procedures and obtained the required permit.


The Board shall not be responsible for motor vehicles that are lost, stolen, or damaged.


3. Delegation of Responsibility

The building Principal or designee shall develop rules and regulations for operating and parking of motor vehicles and shall disseminate those rules to affected students.

The building Principal or designee shall establish standards for granting permits, which contain the warning that infraction of rules, may result in revocation of the permit.

- 1. Driving to and from school Students that desire to use transportation other than school buses must complete a Vehicle Registration Form or Passenger Parental Permission Form. Forms can be obtained in the High School Office. The following procedure is currently in effect:
 - a. Secure, complete and submit the form to the office.
 - b. Student vehicles will park only in the student designated areas.
 - c. Students will not be permitted to go to the parking areas to move their vehicles during the school day without permission of Administration.
 - d. Students leaving school property must obtain office permission.
 - e. No passengers other than those authorized by the office may be carried.
 - f. Only licensed vehicles are permitted on school property.
 - g. All traffic laws that apply while traveling in a school zone must be obeyed.
 - h. Violations of rules will result in the suspension of privileges and disciplinary action.
- 2. Students who drive to school do so with the permission of the Administration. This is a privilege, not a right, and may be withdrawn at any time.
- 3. Students must park their cars in the assigned space.
- 4. It is expected that all students will drive carefully. Reports of reckless driving will result in the loss of driving privileges.
