233.1 DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE

1. As incidents requiring discipline occur, they will be reviewed by the Administrator, Guidance Counselor when necessary, teacher, parent and student involved the day of the infraction. Discipline procedures will be followed, made up of teachers, guidance counselor, and administration, and recommend solutions to the parent/student.

- A. Teacher attempts to correct discipline.
- B. Written referral to Guidance Counselor or Principal.
- C. Parent conference.

- D. Discipline hearing in committee.
- E. Board referral, if desired.

At any phase, all participants may be involved. All parties involved will be informed. Any serious offense, Steps "A" through "D" will be eliminated and incident will be referred to the Board of Education.

- 2. Student complaints of disciplinary action will be handled under the following progression:
 - A. The student should first make the complaint known to the staff member most closely involved or, if none is identifiable. Guidance Counselor, and both shall attempt to resolve the issue informally and directly.
 - B. For complaints which must move beyond the first step, the complaint may be submitted to the building Principal.
 - C. If a solution is not received at the second step, the complaint may be taken to the Superintendent.
 - D. If solution is not received at the third step, the complaint may be submitted to the Board of School Directors at the next regular meeting.
