### 233.2 DETENTION

1. In addition to in-school detention, after-school detention is one of our disciplinary methods. If a student is detained after school, he/she will be given at least one day's notice. It is the responsibility of the student/parents to provide for the student's transportation home.
2. The approved Disciplinary Code is only a partial listing of the many ways in which student's behavior tends to interfere with our educational process and the rights of others. Other infractions will be dealt with accordingly as they occur by the teachers in charge or the Principal.
3. In any case where an offense or violation has occurred, the Administration shall always have the right to refer the offense or violation to the Board of School Directors for hearing and Board action. (It should be noted by the students, parents, and guardians that when the offense or violation is referred to the Board of School Directors, the Board may suspend or expel the student from the school).
4. In any case where an offense or violation has occurred, the Administration shall always have the right to refer the offense or violation to the civil authorities and police, if the offense or violation constitutes a violation of the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for appropriate action.
