## 233.3 DISRUPTION OF NORMAL OPERATIONS

1. Any student who, individually or with other students or persons, causes or attempts to cause any disruption in the normal operation of the schools of the district by refusing to attend classes as scheduled without valid excuse or by any other action or conduct which disrupts, tends to disrupt or is intended to disrupt normal operation of the school, will be subject to discipline as provided in the Student Handbook.
2. Any professional or non-professional employee who, individually or with other employees or with students or other persons, causes or attempts to cause any disruption in the normal operation of the school's District in any manner or way will be subject to appropriate disciplinary action pursuant to the School Code.
3. This policy is not intended to prohibit and shall not be deemed to prohibit lawful labor activity or the lawful exercise of right of expression and association secured by the Constitution of the United States and this state, provided that the exercise of such rights shall not disrupt or tend to disrupt or threatened to disrupt the normal operation of the schools of the District, or, in the case of labor activity, provided that such activity is authorized by law or contract and is within the scope of authority provided by such law or contract.
4. Any professional or non-professional employees having any knowledge of the existence of, or the planning for, any activity prohibited hereunto shall promptly notify the professional employee at the time in charge of the building or place where the activity or planning is occurring of the Superintendent of Schools.
5. The provisions of this policy are in addition to, and not in substitution of, all authority vested in Principals and Teachers and the School Board by the Public School Code or any other applicable law or judicial decision.
