## 233. BEHAVIOR

1. Learning is ineffective unless order is maintained. Therefore, the Principals and teachers in the District are directed to maintain such order in the schools as will facilitate learning by pupils.
2. The Board shall require each student of the District to adhere to the rules and regulations promulgated by the Administration and submit to such disciplinary measures as are appropriately assigned for infraction of those rules.
3. Data regarding disciplinary action may be entered on the student's record in accordance with District policy.
4. Rules and regulations which are described in the Elementary and Secondary School Student Handbook must meet the following criteria:
  - A. Not arbitrary but bear a reasonable relationship to the need to maintain a school environment conducive to learning.
  - B. Not discriminating among students.
  - C. Not demeaning students.
  - D. Not violating any constitutional guaranteed rights.
  - E. Sanctions will relate in kind and degree to the infraction.
  - F. Parents or guardians will be held accountable for actions of their sons, daughters or wards.
5. The Building Principal shall have the authority to assign discipline to students, subject to the rules and regulations as approved by the Board.
6. Teaching staff members and other employees of this Board having authority over students shall have the authority to take such reasonable action as may be necessary to control the disorderly conduct of students in all situations and in all places where such students are within the jurisdiction of the Board and when such conduct interferes with the educational program of the school or threatens the health and safety of others.
7. Any out-of-school suspensions will be for extreme offenses. Any student suspended out-of-school cannot return to school unless accompanied by one or both parents for a conference. Most suspensions will be in-school where the student will be totally isolated from the rest of the student body, including lunch and home room. The student will spend this time working on his/her assignments.
