303.2 QUALIFICATIONS OF THE SUPERINTENDENT

1. PURPOSE. See School Laws of Pennsylvania, Section 1001.
2. ELEGIBILITY. See School Laws of Pennsylvania, Section 1003.
3. PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATIONS.
 - a. The Superintendent of Schools shall remain knowledgeable of advances in the profession through a program of reading, attending professional meetings, and periodic training sessions. The Superintendent may hold membership in the Pennsylvania Association of School Administrators and attend their meetings at the expense of the school system and with prior Board approval.
 - b. The Superintendent must be a wise and sympathetic leader.
 - c. The Superintendent must be of fine moral qualities. Personal integrity and honor must be above question.
 - d. The Superintendent's foremost responsibility is that of directing the instructional program of the school system.
 - e. The Superintendent must be able to interpret the needs and plans of the school system for the staff, the students and residents of the School District.
 - f. SC 1079 and 1078 Commissions.
