COPYRIGHT MATERIAL SOFTWARE</p> <p>The Board recognizes that the United States Code makes it illegal for anyone to duplicate copyrighted materials without permission.</p> <p>The purchaser of a computer program may legally make or have made one (1) copy of that program for archival purposes. Public domain software is copyable without restriction.</p> <p>The copying of protected software through piracy-aids or other means is in violation of the general educational “fair use” provisions of the copyright law.</p> <p>No employee shall copy, support or encourage the copying of computer software other than outlined above. A recognized violation of these guidelines will become a matter for administrative action which may include Board review and legal action.</p>
