ACCEPTABLE USE OF INTERNET

Signature Form

No one may use the District Internet system without a properly signed Signature Form on file within the respective building office. The signed form for each employee-user is valid for the duration of the employee's employment in the district. The signed form indicates that the user (and parent if user is a student) has read, understands, and agrees to abide by the district policy for Acceptable Use of Internet.

Consequences of Misuse

If the daily usage report indicates a pattern of blocked sites which may be indicative of a violation of the district Internet policy, the District will take the following steps:

- 1. Document the nature and extent of the blocked sites in the report.
- 2. Bring the report to the attention of the administrator (who is responsible for that Internet access point) for the purpose of determining if a policy violation has occurred.
- 3. Inform the user regarding the nature of any violation.
- 4. Revoke, through the respective administrator's office, the privilege of Internet use on District technology equipment for that user.
- 5. Report the violation to the appropriate legal authorities (if the violation involves a potential legal offense).
- 6. Seek remuneration for losses incurred by the District.

Community Accounts

In situations where a number of people are using one Internet connection as a group or "community" of users, the following shall apply:

- 1. The community connection is to be made only by an authorized group member using the community account number (account numbers are not to be given out).
- 2. Each user is responsible individually for proper behavior on the Internet.
- 3. Each user must sign the user logbook at that connection site prior to using the Internet.
