904. PUBLIC ATTENDANCE AT SCHOOL EVENTS	
<p>1. Purpose</p>	<p>The Board welcomes the public at athletic and other events held by the school district, but the Board also acknowledges its duty to maintain order and preserve the facilities of the district during such events.</p>
<p>2. Definitions</p> <p>18 Pa. C.S.A. 6305</p>	<p>For the purpose of this policy, tobacco is a lighted or unlighted cigarette, cigar, pipe or other lighted smoking product and smokeless tobacco in any form.</p> <p>For the purpose of this policy, nicotine shall include any product that consists of or contains and form of nicotine that can be ingested by chewing, smoking, inhaling, or through any other means.</p> <p>For the purpose of this policy, a nicotine delivery product shall include, but is not limited to, a device or product used or with the intention of or design for the purpose of ingesting nicotine or another substance. This definition includes, but is not limited to, any device or associated product used for what is commonly referred to as vaping or juuling.</p>
<p>3. Authority</p> <p>SC 511, 775</p>	<p>The Board has the authority to bar the attendance of any person at a school event whose conduct may constitute a disruption. The Board also prohibits alcoholic beverages, gambling, and the use of drugs on school premises.</p>
<p>4. Guidelines</p> <p>20 U.S.C. Sec. 7181 et seq</p> <p>35 P.S. 1223.5</p> <p>School Code 511, 775</p> <p>PA Code Title 22 Sec. 403.1</p>	<p>The Board establishes the following regulations with respect to the conduct of school events.</p> <p>The Board prohibits use of tobacco, nicotine, or a nicotine delivery product by any persons in its school buildings and on any property, buses, vans and vehicles that are owned, leased or controlled by the school district.</p> <p>A schedule of fees for all school events shall be prepared by the Superintendent and adopted by the Board.</p> <p>Senior citizens, residents of the district sixty-five (65) years of age or older, shall be admitted without charge to all school events.</p>
